A local law amending Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1978.

SECTION 1. Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1978 of the Village of Lyndonville, is hereby changed and amended by the addition of Section 2A which reads as follows:

SECTION 2A. It shall be unlawful for any owner or any person harboring any dog in the Village of Lyndonville to permit or allow such dog to run free or out of control between the hours of 7:00 PM prior to garbage collection day and 5:00 PM on garbage collection day.

A violation shall subject the owner or person harboring the dog to fines as provided in Section 11 of the Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1978.

SECTION 2. All local laws, ordinances, rules or regulations, or parts or portions thereof that conflict or are contrary to any provision of this local law are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
