Section 1. The purpose of this Local Law is to authorize public servants of the Village of Lyndonville, New York, to issue and serve appearance tickets in connection with violations of State statutes, local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations of the Village which the public servants are authorized or required to enforce.

Section 2. The following public servants of the Village of Lyndonville are hereby authorized to issue and serve an appearance ticket with respect to violation of state statute, a local law, ordinance, rule or regulation of the Village of Lyndonville, that such public servants are, respectively, required or authorized to enforce:

- A. Assessor; Zoning Officer; and Code Enforcement Official - Building, zoning, planning and enforcement of building or fire codes;
- B. Constables - Parking, public health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. An appearance ticket other than for a parking violation shall be served personally.

Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
