SECTION 1. The following areas are hereby designated as no parking areas in which areas the parking of motor vehicles, except for law enforcement vehicles, at any time shall be unlawful, to wit:

On the west side of Main Street commencing thirteen (13) feet from the south curb line of Creek View Drive to a point eight (8) feet north of the north edge of the Main Street crosswalk.

On the north side of the alley between the Town Hall and the Post Office, commencing at the west curb line of Main Street to the southwest corner of the Town Hall.

SECTION 2. The following area is hereby designated as a handicapped parking area, to wit:

On the west side of Main Street commencing four (4) feet south from the south edge of the Main Street crosswalk for a distance of twenty-two (22) feet from the point of beginning.

SECTION 3. Signs designating such areas as no parking areas and a handicapped area as herein provided are hereby authorized and ordered to be erected and maintained in such areas.

SECTION 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its entry and filing are required by law.


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APPROVAL OF CITY, VILLAGE OR TOWN
