Local Law No. 4 of the year 19 88

A local law prohibiting possession of alcoholic beverages in public places by persons under the age of 21 years and prohibiting the consumption of alcoholic beverages in public places.

Be it enacted by the Lyndonville Board of the

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume any alcoholic beverages in a public place as defined in Section 240 of the Penal Law of the State of New York within the Village of Lyndonville, Orleans County, New York.

Section 2. The foregoing prohibition shall not apply in the event of a fair, picnic, or other community gathering for which special permission has been granted by the Village Board of the Village of Lyndonville specifically granting an exemption for such event from the provisions of this Local Law.

Section 3. No person under 21 years of age shall possess any alcoholic beverage in a public place as defined in Section 240.00 of the Penal Law of the State of New York within the Village of Lyndonville, Orleans County, New York, and any alcoholic beverage found to be in the possession of a person under 21 years of age in any such public place shall be confiscated.

Section 4. A violation of this Local Law shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$250.00 or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. Each separate provision of this Local Law shall be deemed independent of all other provisions herein, and if any provision shall be deemed or declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall remain valid and enforceable.

Section 6. This Local Law shall supersede all prior Local Laws, including Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1978, ordinances, rules and regulations relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the Village of Lyndonville, and they shall be, upon the effective date of this Local Law, null and void.

Section 7. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State as required by law.
