SECTION 1. The following area is hereby designated as a no parking and no standing area in which area the parking or the standing of motor vehicles at any time shall be unlawful, to wit:

On the easterly side of North Main Street commencing at the south curb line of Riverside Avenue to a point forty-eight (48') feet southerly therefrom.

SECTION 2. The following areas are hereby designated as no parking and no standing in which areas the parking or the standing of motor vehicles during the hours of 7:00 A.M. through 4:00 P.M. on days in which school is in session shall be unlawful, to wit:

On the easterly side of North Main Street commencing at fifty (50') feet north from the north curb line of Riverside Avenue for a distance of fifty-six (56') feet from the point of beginning.

On the westerly side of North Main Street commencing one hundred ninety-five (195') feet north from the north line of the bridge over Johnson's Creek for a distance of fifty-six (56') feet from the point of beginning.

SECTION 3. Signs designating such areas as no parking and no standing areas as herein provided are hereby authorized and ordered to be erected and maintained in such areas.

SECTION 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its entry and filing as required by law.


