SECTION 1. Section 190-14E. of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville is hereby changed and amended so as to provide for an increase in the rate charge per 1,000 gallons of ninety (90%) percent of metered water from \$2.70 to \$2.80. The rate schedule shall be as follows:

Class 1 1 service unit, less than 150,000 gpy Availability-vacant parcel	Availability charge: \$80.00 per year; \$2.80 per 1,000 gallons of 90% of metered water \$10.00 per year
Class 2 First service unit Each additional service unit Flow charge Availability-vacant parcel	Availability charge: \$80.00 per year Availability charge: \$40.00 per year \$2.80 per 1,000 gallons of 90% of metered water \$10.00 per year
Class 3 Each service unit Nonprocess waste in excess of 150,000 gpy Availability-vacant parcel	Availability charge: \$240.00 per year \$2.80 per 1,000 gallons of 90% of metered water \$10.00 per year
Class 4 Each service unit Process waste and sanitary Availability-vacant parcel	Availability charge: \$320.00 per year \$2.80 per 1,000 gallons of 90% of metered water; plus charge for excess BOD, suspended solids, COD, acidity, pH and testing per local law \$10.00 per year

SECTION 2. All local laws or regulations, or parts or portions thereof that conflict or are contrary to any provision of this local law are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This local law shall take effect June 1, 1994.
