A local law ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL SPEED LIMIT ON HOUSEL AVENUE

SECTION 225-5.1 SCHOOL SPEED LIMITS

No person shall operate a motor vehicle or motorcycle on any portion of Housel Avenue within the corporate limits of the Village of Lyndonville passing a school building from a point three hundred (300') feet away from the point of intersection of the building line of the school building and the center line of said Housel Avenue to a point measured along the center line of said Housel Avenue three hundred (300') feet away from the point of intersection of the opposite building line of said school building and the center line of said Housel Avenue at a rate of speed in excess of twenty (20) miles per hour. This section shall not apply to ambulances, fire vehicles or police vehicles when on emergency trips.

SECTION 225-5.2 PENALTIES FOR OFFENSES

Every person convicted for a violation of this chapter shall, for a first conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred and 00/100 (\$100.00) Dollars or by imprisonment for not more than fifteen (15) days, or by both such fine or imprisonment; for a second such conviction within eighteen (18) months thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred and 00/100 (\$200.00) Dollars or by imprisonment for not more than forty-five (45) days, or by both such fine or imprisonment; upon a third conviction within eighteen

(18) months after the first conviction such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than Three Hundred and 00/100 (\$300.00) Dollars or by imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
