Local Law No. 1 for the Year 2001

A Local Law Increasing Sewer Rate Charges and Water Rate Charges By Amending Chapters 190 and 230 of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville

Section 1. Section 190-14 (E) of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville is hereby changed and amended so as to provide for an increase in the rate charged per 1,000 gallons of ninety (90%) percent of metered water from \$3.85 to \$3.95. The rate schedule shall be as follows:

Class	Charge
Class 1 1 service unit, less than 150,000 gpy	Availability charge: \$80.00 per year; \$3.95 per 1,000 gallons of 90% metered water

Class 2	
First service unit	Availability charge: \$80.00 per year
Each additional service unit	Availability charge: \$40.00 per year
Flow charge	\$3.95 per 1,000 gallons of 90% of metered water
Class 3	
Each service unit	Availability charge: \$240.00 per year
Nonprocess waste in excess of 150,000 gpy	\$3.95 per 1,000 gallons of 90% of metered water
Class 4	
Each service unit	Availability charge: \$320.00 per year
Process waste and sanitary	\$3.95 per 1,000 gallons of 90% of metered water; plus charge for excess BOD, suspended solids, COD, acidity, pH and testing per local law

Section 2. Section 230-21 of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville is hereby changed and amended so as to provide for an increase in the water rates. The rate schedule shall be as follows:

A. **Inside the Village:** a minimum fee of Thirty-three and 30/100 Dollars (\$33.30) for six thousand (6,000) gallons, plus Five and 55/100 Dollars (\$5.55) per one thousand (1,000) gallons thereafter.

B. **Outside the Village: rural full-use metered service:** A minimum fee of Forty-three and 20/100 Dollars (\$43.20) for six thousand (6,000) gallons, plus Seven and 20/100 Dollars (\$7.20) per one thousand (1,000) gallons thereafter.

C. **Tank Use:** Eight and 00/100 Dollars (\$8.00) per one thousand (1,000) gallons upon application to and approval of the Superintendent of Public Works.

Section 3. All local laws or regulations, or parts or portions thereof that conflict or are contrary to any provision of this local law are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect upon its proper filing as required by law.
