**A LOCAL LAW
EXTENDING TO FOUR (4) YEARS THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE CLERK AND TREASURER
OF THE VILLAGE OF LYNDONVILLE, ORLEANS COUNTY**

1. By enactment of Local Law No. 1 of the year 1990, the Village extended the terms of office of the Mayor and all of the Trustees to four (4) years. The purpose of this Local Law is to extend the term of office of the Treasurer and Clerk to four (4) years pursuant to the provisions of section 3-302(6) of the Village Law of the State of New York.
2. The term of office of the Treasurer and of the Clerk shall be extended to four (4) years, except that the first term shall be of the required number of years so that it shall expire at the end of the term of office of the Mayor then in office. Upon this Local Law becoming effective, the office, the term of which has been extended, shall thereafter be filled for terms of four years, commencing at the expiration of the term of office of the Treasurer and Clerk at the time this Local Law is adopted.
3. This Local Law is adopted subject to permissive referendum.
4. This Local Law shall take effect thirty (30) days after adoption thereof or after approval by one affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified voters of the Village of Lyndonville voting on a proposition for its approval, after Petition, whichever event first occurs.

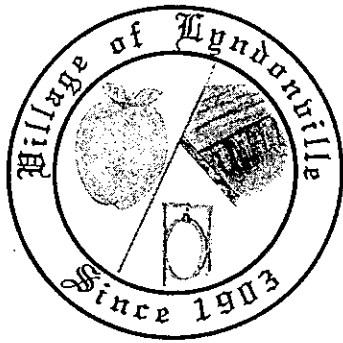
