Local Law prohibiting Throwing Refuse on Sidewalks, Streets and Adjacent Lands, and Public Lands Within the Village of Lyndonville

- Section 1.** Within the Village of Lyndonville, no person shall throw, dump, deposit or place, or cause to be thrown, dumped, deposited or placed upon any sidewalk, street or road, or within such street or road right of way or upon private lands adjacent thereto, or upon any public land owned by the Village of Lyndonville or Town of Yates, any refuse, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter or any nauseous or offensive matter.
- Section 2.** Nothing herein contained shall be construed as prohibiting the use in a reasonable manner of ashes, sand, salt or other material for the purpose of reducing the hazard of, or providing traction on snow, ice or sleet.
- Section 3.** A violation of this Local Law shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars and for any second or subsequent violation within one (1) year by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars.
- Section 4.** This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the department of State pursuant to law.
