**Local Law Regulating Parking, Standing and Stopping Motor Vehicles for the Village of Lyndonville**

- Section 1.** The provisions of this Local Law shall apply except when it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device.
- Section 2.** No person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts thereof of the Village of Lyndonville in areas which have been sign posted pursuant to local law, ordinance, order, rule or regulation duly enacted, adopted or promulgated by the Village Board of the Village of Lyndonville.
- Section 3.** No person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts thereof of the Village of Lyndonville out of a stall which has been duly designated and lined pursuant to local law, ordinance, order, rule or regulation duly enacted, adopted or promulgated by the Village Board of the Village of Lyndonville.
- Section 4.** The parking of vehicles is prohibited on all streets within the Village of Lyndonville and in all public parking lots and areas in the Village of Lyndonville between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. beginning November 1 and ending March 31 of each year.
- Section 5.** No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any streets or parts thereof of the Village of Lyndonville so as to (a) block a driveway, (b) double park, (c) park less than 15 feet from a fire hydrant, (d) park with the wrong side of the vehicle to a curb, (e) park in a fire lane, (f) park on a sidewalk.

- Section 6.** It shall be a violation for any person to stop, stand or park a vehicle in any area or parking space designated as a place for handicapped parking, unless the vehicle bears a permit issued under the Vehicle and Traffic Law.
- Section 7.** (a) Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Local Law, except Section 6, shall for a first conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, for a second conviction within eighteen (18) months thereafter, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars; upon a third or subsequent conviction within eighteen (18) months after the first conviction such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars.
- (b) Any person who stops, stands or parks in spaces marked for use by the handicapped without a proper permit shall be subject to a fine of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for the first offense and One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for the second offense or subsequent offense occurring within a period of two (2) years.
- Section 8.** All prior inconsistent Local Law or Ordinances or parts thereof are hereby rescinded and repealed.
- Section 9.** If any provision of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the provision directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.
- Section 10.** This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to law.
