A Local Law Increasing Sewer Availability Charges By Amending Chapter 190 of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville

Section 1. Section 190-14 (E) of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville is hereby changed and amended so as to provide for an increase in the sewer availability charges imposed on each class. The rate schedule effective December 1, 2013 shall be as follows:

Class	Charge
Class 1 1 service unit, less than 150,00 gpy	Availability charge: \$100.00 per year; \$5.20 per 1,000 gallons of 95% metered water
Class 2 First service unit	Availability charge: \$100.00 per year
Each additional service unit	Availability charge: \$50.00 per year
Flow charge	\$5.20 per 1,000 gallons of 95%

of metered water

Class 3
Each service unit
Nonprocess waste in excess of
150,000 gpy

Availability charge: \$260.00 per
year \$5.20 per 1,000 gallons of 95%
of metered water

Class 4
Each service unit
Process waste and sanitary

Availability charge: \$340.00 per year
\$5.20 per 1,000 gallons of 95%
metered water; plus charge for
excess BOD, suspended solids,
COD, acidity, pH and testing per
local law

Section 2. All local laws or regulation, or parts or portions thereof that conflict or are contrary to any provision of this local law are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its proper filing as required by law.


