Available Vaccination Clinics for those who are prioritized as 1A and 1B (you must have proof of employment or verification by your agency showing you meet the criteria for these priority groups):

You must attest that you are eligible to receive vaccine in the 1a and 1B Priority Groups. By getting the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine you are agreeing that you will abide by your appointment for a second dose. This appointment will be made at the time of the first dose administration.

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COVID-19 Vaccination Prioritization Phase 1A

As of 01/04/21, the following are in the Phase 1A Priority Group (the state determines who is in the priority groups, not the local health department):

- Staff and residents of behavioral and mental health settings and institutions;
- Staff from other health care facilities;
- Staff from public and privately operated COVID-19 testing locations/operations or laboratory settings;
- Medical examiners, coroners, and funeral workers who are exposed to infectious materials or bodily fluids;
- All outpatient/ambulatory front-line, high-risk health care workers of any age who provide direct in-person patient care, or other staff in a position in which they have direct contact with patients (i.e., intake staff), will be eligible;
 - This includes but is not limited to, individuals who work in private medical practices; hospital-affiliated medical practices; public health clinics; specialty medical practices of all types; dental practices of all types; dialysis workers; diagnostic and treatment centers; occupational therapists; physical therapists; speech therapists; phlebotomists; behavioral health workers; and student health workers;
- All front-line, high-risk public health workers who have direct contact with patients, including those conducting COVID-19 tests, those handling COVID-19 lab specimens and COVID-19 vaccinations, will be eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccine;
- Home care workers and aides, hospice workers, personal care aides, and consumer-directed personal care workers;
- Staff and residents of nursing homes, skilled nursing facilities, and adult care facilities.

All Phase 1a priority group members will be attesting they are in the priority group and proof of qualification will be checked. Individuals are to bring proof of employment or verification by your agency that you fit the criteria for this priority group.

Proof may include an employee ID card, a letter from an employer or affiliated organization, a pay stub, provider agreement or copy of your professional license.

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COVID-19 Vaccination Prioritization Phase 1B



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As of 01/12/21, the following are in the Phase 1B Priority Group (the state determines who is in the priority groups, not the local health department):

- Individuals Age 65 and older – please bring proof of age
- First Responder and Support Staff for First Responder Agency
 - Fire Service
 - State Fire Service, including firefighters and investigators (professional and volunteer)
 - Local Fire Services, including firefighters and investigators (professional and volunteer)
 - Police and Investigations
 - State Police, including Troopers
 - State Park Police, DEC Police, Forest Rangers
 - SUNY Police
 - Sheriffs' Offices
 - County Police Departments and Police Districts
 - City, Town, and Village Police Departments
 - Transit of other Public Authority Police Departments
 - State Field Investigations, including Department of Motor Vehicles, State Commission of Correction, Justice Center, Department of Financial Services, Inspector General, Department of Tax and Finance, Office of Children and Family Services and State Liquor Authority
 - Public Safety Communications
 - Emergency Communication and Public Safety Answering Point Personnel, including dispatchers and technicians
 - Other Sworn and Civilian Personnel
 - Court Officers
 - Other Police or Peace Officers
 - Support of Civilian Staff for Any of the above services, agencies, or facilities
 - Corrections
 - State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision Personnel, including correction and parole officers



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- Local Correctional Facilities, including correction officers
- Local Probation Departments, including probation officers
- State Juvenile Detention and Rehabilitation Facilities
- Local Juvenile Detention and Rehabilitation Facilities
- P-12 Schools
- P-12 school or school district faculty or staff (includes all teachers, substitute teachers, student teachers, school administrators, paraprofessional staff and support staff including bus drivers)
- Contractors working in a P-12 school or school district (including contracted bus drivers)
- Licensed, registered, approved or legally exempt group Childcare
- Licensed, registered, approved or legally exempt group Childcare Providers
- Employees or Support Staff of Licensed or Registered Childcare Setting
- Licensed, Registered, Approved or Legally Exempt Childcare Providers
- Public Transit
- Airline and airport employees
- Passenger railroad employees
- Subway and mass transit employees (i.e., MTA, LIRR, Metro North, NYC Transit, Upstate transit)
- Ferry employees
- Port Authority employee
- Public bus employee
- Individuals living in a homeless shelter where sleeping, bathing or eating accommodations must be shared with individuals and families who are not part of your household
- Individual working (paid or unpaid) in a homeless shelter where sleeping, bathing or eating accommodations must be shared by individuals and families who are not part of the same household, in a position where there is potential for interaction with shelter residents
- Public-facing grocery store workers
- In-person college instructors



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Prior to receiving the vaccination, you must complete the [New York State COVID-19 Vaccine Form](#). This form can be completed [online](#) and you will receive a submission ID, or you can fill out the form at your vaccination site. Individuals being vaccinated must bring proof of eligibility to the vaccination site. This may include an employee ID card, a letter from an employer or affiliated organization, or a pay stub, depending on the specific priority status.
