SECTION 216-1. The percentum of exemption allowed pursuant to Section 485-b of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York as regards real property located in the Village of Lyndonville, New York, is hereby reduced to 0 percentum for each of the ten (10) years described in Subparagraph 2(a) of said Section 485-b of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York so that said Section 2(a) of said Section 485-b of the said Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York as it effects and applies to real property situate in the Village of Lyndonville, New York, shall read as follows:

> Such real property shall be exempt for a period of one (1) years to the extent of 0 percentum of the increase in assessed value thereof attributable to such construction, alteration, installation or improvement, and for an additional period of nine (9) years provided, however, that the extent of such exemption shall be decreased by 0 percentum each year during such additional period of nine (9) years.
