A LOCAL LAW INCREASING SEWER RATE CHARGES AND WATER RATE CHARGES BY AMENDING CHAPTERS 190 AND 230 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF LYNDONVILLE

Section 1. Section 190-14 (E) of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville is hereby changed and amended so as to provide for an increase in the rate charged per 1,000 gallons of ninety (90%) percent of metered water from \$3.95 to \$4.75. The rate schedule shall be as follows:

- **Section 2.** Section 230-21 of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville is hereby changed and amended so as to provide for an increase in the water rates. The rate schedule shall be as follows:
 - A. Inside the Village: a minimum fee of Forty and 68/100 Dollars (\$40.68) for six thousand (6,000) gallons, plus Six and 78/100 Dollars (\$6.78) per one thousand (1,000) gallons thereafter.
 - B. Outside the Village: rural full-use metered service: A minimum fee of Fifty-two and 68/100 Dollars (\$52.68) for six thousand (6,000) gallons, plus Eight and 78/100 Dollars (\$8.78) per one thousand (1,000) gallons thereafter.
 - C. Tank Use: Nine and 25/100 Dollars (\$9.25) per one thousand (1,000) gallons upon application to and approval of the Superintendent of Public Works.
- **Section 3.** All local laws or regulations, or parts or portions thereof that conflict or are contrary to any provision of this local law are hereby repealed.
- Section 4. This local law shall take effect upon its proper filing as required by law.
