On the Easterly side of North Main Street commencing at the south curb line of Riverside Avenue to a point forty-eight (48') feet southerly thereform.

On the southerly side of Maple Avenue commencing at the east boundary of the crosswalk to a point sixty-two (62') feet easterly therefrom.
