A Local Law Increasing Sewer Rate Charges By Amending Chapter 190 of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville

Section 1. Section 190-14 (E) of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville is hereby changed and amended so as to provide for an increase in the rate charged per 1,000 gallons of ninety-five (95%) percent of metered water from \$4.75 to \$5.00. The rate schedule shall be as follows:
