## A Local Law Providing for Discontinuance of Water Service

**Section 1.** Section 230-18 of the Village Code of the Village of Lyndonville is hereby repealed and rescinded. In its place and stead, a new Section 230-18 is hereby enacted which shall provide as follows:

Should the owner of property or consumer water fail to pay water rents or to comply with any of the provisions of this chapter and any amendments thereto the Board of Water Commissioners, in addition to any other remedies granted to it, may discontinue the water supply to such premises. On five days notice to such owner or consumer, if water service is so terminated at a premises that has been issued a certificate of occupancy under Chapter 240, Zoning, of the Code of the Village of Lyndonville or under any other local law, ordinance, rule or regulation of the Village or enforced by the Village, such certificate of occupancy shall be automatically suspended, and if the premises are inhabited, such premises shall be vacated pursuant to Village code enforcement procedures. Such certificate of occupancy shall not be reinstated or reissued until water service has been reestablished and the premises have been inspected by the Code of Enforcement Officer and it has been determined that the premises are in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, rules and regulations and, in the case of inhabited premises, that the same are now safe for habitation. There shall be a fee, as set from time to time by the Board of Trustees, payable by the owner to the Village Treasurer for the cost of such inspection and for reissuance of the certificate of occupancy. The Board of Trustees may, from time to time, increase or reduce such fee by resolution.

## Section 2.

- (a) This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
- (b) If any part or section of this Local Law shall be held to be invalid, the remaining provisions thereof shall not fail but shall remain in full force and effect.
- (c) All local laws, ordinances, rules or regulations, or parts or portions thereof that conflict or are contrary to any portion of this Local Law are hereby repealed.
